### **Pre-Conference Workshop**

**Wednesday, June 8 & 9, 2011 – 8:00am – 5:00pm**

#### **FISDAP Item Writing Class**

In this workshop, the participant will develop skills to write better exams and quizzes, review test items for accuracy and validity, and prepare students for the NREMT Cognitive Exam. The participant will also learn how criterion-based exams like the National Registry exam are written, FISDAP's valid, reliable, and predictive exams are developed, and how to get discounted or free access to FISDAP testing. Lunch is provided.

#### **PER-211, Medical Management of CBRNE Events**

This course will equip first responders and first receivers with the skills needed to ensure proper patient triage, treatment, and transportation in the event of exposure to chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and explosive (CBRNE) weapons. The course delivery methodology consists of facilitated discussions, small group exercises, hands-on activities, and task oriented practical applications using both adult and pediatric human patient simulators to promote critical thinking skills while utilizing the RAPID Care concept. Exercises conducted in a CBRNE scenario will reinforce classroom lectures and interaction. Participants will use their training to demonstrate proper techniques for assessment, triage, mass decontamination considerations, treatment and stabilization. In addition, course participants will receive training on the proper techniques for protecting themselves and limiting cross-contamination. Lunch is provided. For more info on this class go to;

#### **CDLS – Core Disaster Life Support**

This course is a pre-requisite of BDLS and ADLS. It is a competency-based, awareness-level course that introduces clinical and public health concepts and principles for the management of disasters and public health emergencies, incorporating the “all-hazards” approach to personal, institutional, and community disaster management through the use of two unique mnemonics, the PRE-DISASTER Paradigm. CDLS provides participants from diverse professions, disciplines, and backgrounds with a common lexicon, vocabulary, and knowledge in disaster-related medicine and public health that can be reinforced and expanded in the BDLS and ADLS Courses.
