### NOTICE OF EMS CERTIFICATION COMMISSION VACANCY

Released May 18, 2011

The Louisiana EMS Certification Commission is created under R.S.40:1232.2 to safeguard life and health of the citizens of Louisiana. To fulfill this purpose, the Commission is delegated the responsibility to establish and publish standards of out-of-hospital practice, regulate the scope of practice of Emergency Medical Service professionals, discipline and regulate the practice of Emergency Medical Services professionals, and establish standards for educational programs preparing individuals for out-of-hospital practice.

The Commission is now accepting resumes for the following upcoming vacancies:


- Physician from the American Academy of Pediatrics
- EMT (Paramedic or Basic) who is also a certified instructor by the bureau of EMS
- EMT (Paramedic or Basic) who is also a certified instructor by the bureau of EMS and appointed by the Louisiana Fire Chiefs Association

Each member of the Commission shall be a resident of Louisiana for at least one year, have had three years experience in his respective field of practice, and be actively engaged in the practice of emergency medical services at the time of his appointment. Each member shall be appointed to serve a term of three years, and shall serve no more than two consecutive terms.

To apply for the vacancy, you must submit a cover letter indicating the vacancy for which you are applying along with a resume or curriculum vitae to the Emergency Medical Services Task Force no later than July 1, 2011. Letters of recommendation are encouraged. Please submit packages to:
